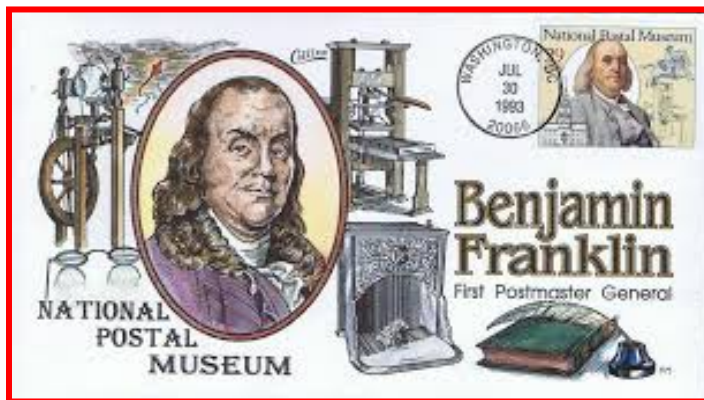


2024 Summer Letterbox Clue 1

The Kenosha Public Library has four (soon to be 5!) public library branches. Your first challenge is to correctly identify in which of these four you will find the letter box.

The correct branch to start your hunt is between the station where the siren sounds emergency trouble and little piggy's market. If you find yourself at the branch where the bookmobile sleeps for the night, you are in the right place.



Did you know that in 1775, Benjamin Franklin was named the 1st Postmaster General of the Postal Service? Over the last 250 years, the US postal service drop boxes have changed colors 5 times! They started green then went red, then white and back to green. Finally in 1955, it was decided postal drop boxes would be red, white and BLUE.

At this branch, our Postmaster General is Nadia and she has her own blue box. The letterbox with the stamp that you seek lies under Nadia's blue box. Be sneaky! Try not to give away the hiding place to people in the area.

Once you find it, you have succeeded! Please open it, date and sign your names in the logbook, and add a short message for fellow searchers. Use the stamp included to stamp your personal logbook and then return it to the box. Do not take the stamp. There is a unique stamp in each KPL branch letterbox, so be sure to find all four!
