The Door to Nowhere?



The Kenosha Public Library system is made up of over four different locations throughout the city of Kenosha. Only one of them is named after a person and built in memory of them. Designed by Daniel H. Burnham, this building was built with symmetry as a main focal point, as was the style with Neo-classical buildings.

When you step inside the building you will see that each of the corners of the rotunda has a door and two columns flanking it. All four doors are functional, but only 3 actually lead somewhere in the building. Find the “Door to Nowhere” and peek behind to find your prize.
